Oklahoma Indian Missionary Conference

October 25-29, 2006

Join a Central Texas Conference Adult UMVIM (United Methodist Volunteers in Mission) team this fall serving the Oklahoma Indian Missionary Conference (OIMC). The cost of the trip will be **\$250, plus meals while traveling.**

The OIMC was established in 1844 to serve “distinctly Indian congregations.” Many of the churches are historic, having been around since the tribes were forcibly removed from their homelands beginning in the early 1840s. The CTC team will assist with vital repairs for OIMC churches that cannot afford to contract the work nor do it on their own. Not only will the project provide a rewarding volunteer opportunity, participants will also enjoy a unique cultural experience.

No construction experience is necessary—all skill levels are welcome. All participants will be asked to attend **one planning meeting at 6:00pm on September 27, 2006**, location to be determined and central to registered participants. *Please register by September 1, 2006.*
